## How Do I Obtain A South Dakota Commercial Applicator License Through Reciprocity?

South Dakota offers a reciprocal Commercial Applicators License to commercial applicators who have tested (took the Commercial Pesticide Applicator exam) in a state that adjoins South Dakota:



South Dakota Department of Agriculture will contact your licensing state to verify the authenticity and status of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state.

If you did not test in an adjoining state you are not eligible for reciprocity in South Dakota.



## What Documents Do I Need?

- Your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state; and
- A government issued photo ID

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## Online Application Process

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- Email a request for a reciprocal license to [sddaagronomy@state.sd.us](mailto:sddaagronomy@state.sd.us) and attach an electronic copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state; *or*
- Fax a request for a reciprocal license to (605) 773-3481 including a legible copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state; *or*
- Mail a request for a reciprocal license and include a legible copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state. Send to: South Dakota Department of Agriculture, Office of Agronomy Services, 523 E Capitol Ave, Foss Building, Pierre, SD 57500

### Immediately Contact Us:

- Contact us at (605) 773-4432 to obtain a log-in ID to apply or pay online, then
- go to the SDDA [Commercial Applicator Registration for Recertification Classes and License Renewal](#) online site, complete the information;
- If you are an *aerial applicator*, make sure you complete the aerial applicator form also; and
  - pay the license fee online with Visa or MasterCard select the "Pay with credit card" button; or
  - pay the fee with a check using the online process, select the "Mail in payment" button.

- A **legible** copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state;
- a **legible** color image (scan or photo) of your government issued photo ID:

## Mail In Application Process

- Fax a request for a reciprocal license to (605) 773-3481 including a legible copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state; *or*
- Mail a request for a reciprocal license and include a legible copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state. Send to: South Dakota Department of Agriculture, Office of Agronomy Services, 523 E Capitol Ave, Foss Building, Pierre, SD 5750; *or*
- Email a request for a reciprocal license to [sddaagronomy@state.sd.us](mailto:sddaagronomy@state.sd.us) and attach an electronic copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state.



### **Include These Documents With your request:**

- A **legible** copy of your current Commercial Pesticide Applicator credential from the adjoining state;

## Commercial Applicators License

### General Information

Commercial applicator certification is valid for two years\*. Several [specific categories](#) of commercial certification are available. Once certified in the categories you need, commercial applicators must obtain a biennial license before engaging in business. In 2009 more than 6,000 commercial applicators were licensed in South Dakota.

\*The date of the initial certification plus one year.

It may take up to **14 days** from the time you submit your paperwork and/or take the exam to obtain a Commercial Applicators License. Longer times may apply if there are deficiencies in your paperwork.

- **You will need a Commercial Applicators license if:**
  - \* You engage in the business of applying pesticides to the lands of another;
  - \* You advertise as being in the business of applying pesticides to the lands of another at any time;
  - \* You apply pesticides while in the performance of duties as a governmental employee or;
  - \* You otherwise act as a commercial applicator.
