2011-2012 Compensation Rates for Personnel and Equipment when DOA provides assistance through local contractors are as follows:

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1. Reimbursement for Meals and Lodging. Compensation for meals and lodging is at the discretion of the incident commander. The first meal shall be provided by the State. Reimbursement of lodging and meals for Contractor personnel will be based on per diem rates and rules established for the State of South Dakota.

a. **Lodging**

Reimbursement for lodging will be based on receipts and will not exceed current state rate per night per individual. Receipts for multiple occupancy must show the single rate and the multiple occupancy rates. Individual reimbursement will be based on the total room rate (plus tax) divided by the number of occupants. The current State reimbursement rate is \$ 46.50 per day.

b. **Meals**

Reimbursement for meals will be based on and cannot exceed current State per diem rates. Tips are not reimbursable. State rates are, Breakfast - \$5.00, Lunch - \$9.00, and Dinner - \$12.00. (These rates are subject to change.)

2. Compensation Rates for Contract Personnel. The State will receive compensation for personnel at the following hourly rates.

** Rates will change when the new rates are published in the Interagency Incident Business Management Handbook by National Wildfire Coordinating Group. You will be sent a replacement page for your contract, when the new rates are published. You will also be able to find the current rates under Fire Business on the Website mentioned above.

3. Compensation Rates for Fire Engines and Tenders. The Contractor will be compensated for engines and tenders based on the following base hourly rates.

The Cooperator shall be compensated for personnel according to the function they fill on an incident. If filling a function for which they are not fully qualified, as per training and experience required under PMS 310-1, the individual will be paid one classification lower except in those instances where an Overhead trainee is not working under direction of a fully qualified individual in that position, in which case the trainee is entitled to the identified full rate. Individuals filling positions will be compensated according to the rates established in the “*Interagency Incident Business Management Handbook*”, current effective federal AD Pay Plan located at <http://sdda.sd.gov/WFS/division/firebusiness/default.aspx>.

CAFS – Add \$20.00 per hour for engines equipped with CAFS

Hourly rates are wet rates. Flight rates are adjusted when fuel prices change. The **STATE** will reimburse the **CONTRACTOR** for all contractor supplied foam or fire retardant expended during the course of the incident and contractor will attach a usage log to the bill.

The **CONTRACTOR** will log and bill flight time in 1/10-hour increments. Times will be rounded to the next higher 1/10-hour increment.

2012-2013 Compensation Rates for State Personnel on In-State County Rangeland Fire Agreement:

The State will receive compensation for personnel at the rates published by the National Wildfire Coordinating group in chapter 10. You will be sent a replacement page for your contract, when the new rates are published. Overtime is 1.5 X the rate.
